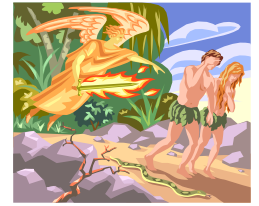
Thank you to Mr. & Mrs. Ladeira for their Kind donation of tomato plants.
