



Llanbedr Christmas Lights : Switch on - Friday 4th December



4.00 - 7.00 p.m. Old St Peters Church

Follow a path of light & music up to the Travelling Nativity scene at Old St Peters Church from 4.00 pm to 7.00pm, in household units & a max of 30 people at a time. (Social distancing rules will be observed & monitored along the lane and around the church yard.) Participants are also encouraged to bring torches as well as a night light in a jam jar to leave at the site. Mince pies and hot chocolate will be available.



5.00 - 6.30 p.m. Village Christmas float

At 5pm the tree lights in the slate garden will be switched on, as well as the lights around the Community Hall. A car and trailer, playing Christmas music, will then go around the village on a set route (starting at Hirwaen end and culminating at Llanbedr Hall end. It will start at the slate garden, where a dedication will be said before officially lighting the Christmas tree. We want to encourage ALL residents to provide external/internal lights to their property or even some night lights in jam jars on the doorstep, to participate in the village lights "switch on "
